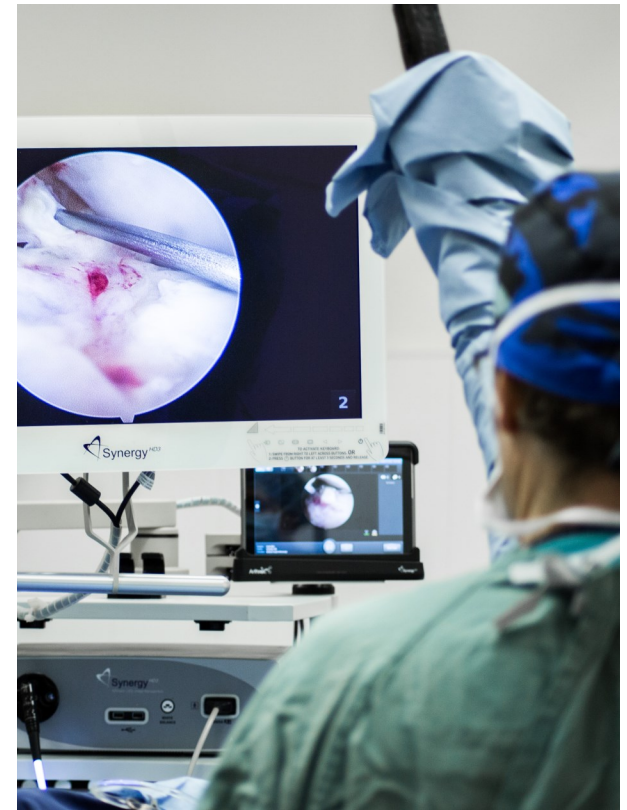

ABOUT THE CLINIC

Our case load is primarily equine with a very small percentage of bovine, camelid, and small ruminants. The practice provides general veterinary medical services on both an ambulatory and in-hospital basis.

Moore Equine is the largest Equine Practice in Canada and also one of the main referral centres for Western Canada. We provide high quality lameness examinations, surgery, diagnostic imaging, pre purchase examinations, equine dentistry, reproduction, and alternative therapies.



Our main hospital has 20 indoor stalls, 15 outdoor stalls, 1 surgical suite with 2 recovery rooms, 4 examination rooms, an indoor lameness examination centre, an isolation facility with 2 stalls, and bovine facilities. We offer a full spectrum of surgical services. We also have advanced imaging capabilities with a nuclear scintigraphy unit, and a Hallmarq Standing MRI.

At our south clinic location is our Reproduction facilities which offer embryo transfer, AI, and supervised foaling. Also located at our south clinic is our Rehabilitation Facilities which include a water treadmill, exercise walker, Class IV laser, Therapeutic Ultrasound, Shockwave Therapy and much more!
